Deposit & Registration Fees

- A \$15 non-refundable deposit is required for each camp week at the time of registration.

- Change requests must be made by Thursday at 12:00 PM for the following week's session. Fees may apply.
- All remaining camp tuition is automatically charged 8 days before the start of each camp week.

Tiny Trailblazers is a great first-time summer program experience for young children. This summer program offering is designed for kids who will be entering Kindergarten in the fall.
